1. What does EYFs stand for?- Early years foundation stage
2. There are 7 areas of learning, which are Prime areas and what ones are Specific areas? Prime- CL, PSED, PD. Specific- UW, M, L, EAD.
3. What does EAL stand for?- English additional language
4. How can you make your activity more inclusive for EAL children?- Visual aids/tablet, words from home, small groups(one-to-one)
5. What type of assessments do we complete at Ruislip stars?- On-entry, Observations, 2-year checks, EYDJ, My support plan.

14. What needs to be completed before going on an outing- risk assessment, suncream, permissions, high vis, medication, ratio, register
